

## **DIRECTIONS TO THE HATCHERY SITE**

The Hatchery at Sequoia Resort  
50616 Hwy. 245  
Badger, CA 93603

### **From the South:**

Head north on Highway 99

Merge onto Highway 198 toward Visalia

Continue through Visalia until you arrive at Lemon Cove

After Lemon Cove, turn left after Prince Gas (last gas station) on Road 216

After 1/2 mile, crossing the Kaweah river, turn right onto Dry Creek Rd.

Go all the way up until a stop sign at Highway 245 (Mountain House at intersection)

Turn right (going straight ahead) onto Highway 245

1-1/2 miles after the old Badger store, pass a CDF fire station on the left

The Hatchery (at Sequoia resort) is located just beyond the fire station – there is a entry gate on the right

Follow signs from gate to The Hatchery building and parking

### **From the North:**

Head south on Highway 99

Merge onto Highway 180

Look for Highway 180 to turn off to the left after the town of Minkler – follow Highway 180 through Squaw Valley (last gas station)

Turn right onto Dunlap Road

Continue on Dunlap Road until you reach stop sign at Highway 245

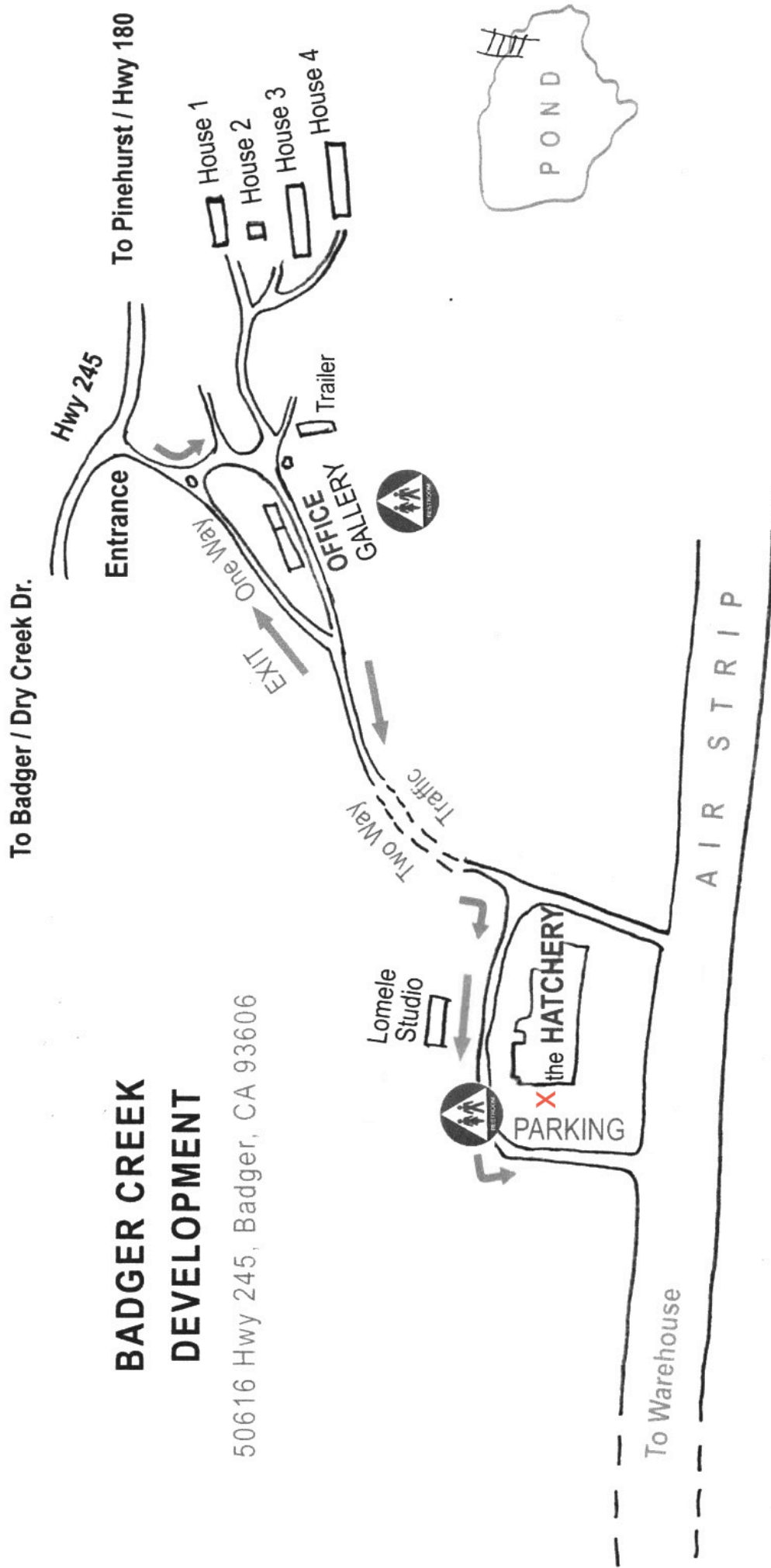
Take a sharp right (a "U" turn) onto Highway 245

After 3 miles on Highway 245, you will see the entry gate to Sequoia Resort (The Hatchery) on the left

Follow signs from gate to The Hatchery building and parking

## **INFORMATION FOR VISITING THE HATCHERY**

This exhibition consists of scheduled performance pieces, beginning at 2:00pm. Please plan to arrive on site by 1:45pm. The performance program will run for approximately 2 hours.

Note that there are no services (gas stations, food, etc.) immediately around The Hatchery location. Water and restrooms will be provided on site. Guests are welcome to bring food and picnic on the grounds before or after the performance event. Cell phone reception is unreliable in the area.

## **SAFETY**

Guest will be required to read and sign a liability waiver before entering the exhibition site.

Be aware that rattlesnakes live in grassy areas, brush and trashed areas (such as the trailers behind the Hatchery building). Do not step where you cannot see.

Wear close-toed shoes – no sandals or flip-flops allowed inside the building.

Use caution inside the Hatchery building. Watch where you step, look for broken glass, nails and uneven surfaces.

Children are allowed at the exhibition, but must be under close adult supervision, particularly upstairs in the Hatchery building or around the trailers behind the building.

**DO NOT ENTER AREAS THAT HAVE BEEN ROPED OFF FOR YOUR SAFETY.** Anyone found violating this rule will be asked to leave the property immediately.

In case of emergency, go to the Sequoia Resort office on site and dial 911 using the landline phone.
